
Half Circle/Circular Tree Bench Manual

Parts Included:


2 Cedar Seat Panels 1 $^{1/2"}$ W x 23" straight slats – 4 $1^{1/2"}$ W x 19 $^{3/4"}$ angle supports – 6 2 ^{3/8"}W x 17" wood bench legs- 6 4" screws-4






- 2 ^{3/4"} Screws- 6






1. Setting one seat panel, match one of the wood legs to the inside portion of the bench. Using a 2 $^{3/4"}$ bolt attach the leg to the bench. Then setup one of the angle supports and match one end to the leg as shown above using a 3 $^{1/2"}$ bolt while using a 3 $^{1/4"}$ bolt to secure the other end directly onto the bench.



2. Setup the other leg as shown on the previous step using the same bolts and pieces.



3. Set up the two seat pieces as shown above and using the 23" straight slabs match the four corresponding holes and secure the midsection of the bench using 3 ^{1/4} " bolts along the bottom while the 23" piece used along the top will use the 3 $^{1/4"}$ bolts at the far right and left end holes only.



4. Have the bench face toward you and install the angle supports as noted in the above left hand picture while using two 4" bolts to secure the mid-section. At the corners, as noted on the right hand picture use the 3 ^{1/4"} bolts. Once completed with the middle section, complete the other side of the bench exactly as stated in steps 1-2. Full circle benches are constructed the same way by setting up two half benches together.
